

Imperial Winter Series – Race Code

Remember this is in a public park and people may be walking across the circuit.

Bikes :-

- Diamond-style frame (steel, alloy or carbon fibre).
- Equal-sized wheels of spoked construction.
- 12 or more spokes in each wheel alloy or carbon/composite.
- Minimum weight 6.8kg
- No aero bars or handlebar extensions.
- No mudguards or under saddle bags.
- Well-maintained condition.



Before getting on the circuit :-

- Check that nothing is loose or hanging off your bike.
- Bottles sit tight in bottle cage.
- Helmet on securely – no excuses.
- No peaks on helmets.
- Race number in correct position for photo finish camera.

On the circuit :-

- Listen to the Commissaires race instructions.
- Hands on handle bars at all times.
- Keep in a straight line.
- Do not switch or swerve.
- Make sure you can put your bottle back in its cage with out looking down.
- Do not look around - look forward.
- Do not look down; if something is mechanically wrong pull off the circuit and stop, you can take a lap out.
- Do not attempt to go through gaps that are not big enough to do safely, do not barge through.
- Concentrate all the time on your position and the position of other riders, stay alert.
- If involved in a crash do not leave without checking with 1st Aid.
- You may get a showering of bodily fluids – that’s racing; so hold your line!

After the finish :-

- Carry on over the finish line. Do not stop.
- Do NOT turn around and ride back.
- Do a lap slowly keeping to the outside of the circuit then exit at the circuit entrance but be aware of fellow riders still racing.
- Then keep off the circuit as others may still be racing round.

Other stuff :-

- You are expected to race in your club (as stated on your licence) kit or plain kit.
- Sign on opens 1 hour prior to the race.
- Changing rooms and lockers are in club house. Please note shower facilities are available for free in the Goals centre (you will need to buy a token for the lockers – 20p in the machine by the front door).
- We run the winter series as unisex races (with the exception of the womens only races).
- 3rd Cats you will be allowed to change races only once (ie from 3rd cat race to E123)
- Only Youths with Dispensation licences will be allowed to race in the senior races.
- 4th Cats that earn 10 BC points during this series will be moved up to the 3rd cat race but not the E123 race.
- **BC** points will only be issued to full licence holders – so make sure it’s up to date.
- This is a **BC** event, Non **BC** member fees apply.

- Life membership is available to those having 10 years consecutive membership
- Standard clubs/teams renewing their affiliation before December 31st each year will receive a £25 discount
- Commercially named clubs/teams renewing their affiliation before December 31st each year will receive a £50 discount
- Sponsor fees are payable for up to four registered sponsors of any club/team. Further sponsors are registered free
- The affiliation fee paid by a commercially named club/team shall include the sponsor fee of its main sponsor
- Registered and Accredited Go-Ride clubs are exempt from paying any sponsorship fees

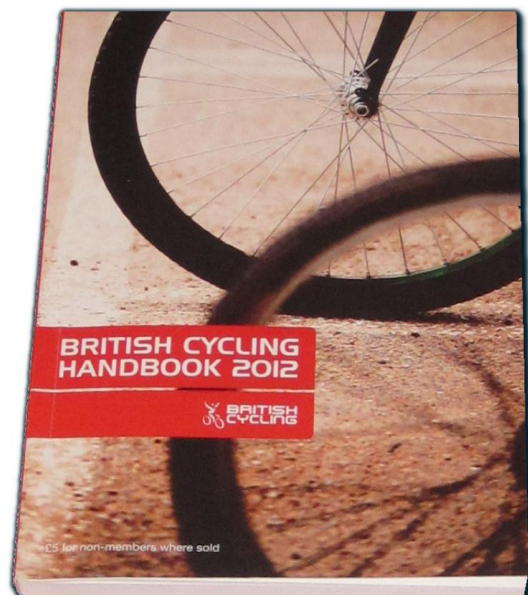
Additional Information

- Juniors are charged 50% of the senior fees
- Youth non-Race members are charged at £1.50
- Single Day Licences are not applicable to national events
- Riders not presenting a valid full racing licence at national events will be required to pay a £10 surcharge

NEW LICENCE

For those riders wishing to compete in the BC Winter Series races but who do not have a race licence, the advice is to apply for a 2012 one to cover races in December, which will qualify them for upgrading category points to be allocated in 2013.

Although they will have to pay the £32.00 for the 2012 licence, they will automatically be sent a 2013 licence at the start of the New Year with no further payment necessary. Obviously this inclusive payment only applies to end of year applications.
